### **ERASMUS+KA 171 2022– Higher education student and staff mobility between Programme and Partner Countries**

OPEN CALL for the selection of **short-term student mobility** from the Nelson Mandela African Institution of Science and Technology (NM-AIST) at the Rhine-Waal University of Applied Sciences, Germany. The call is part of the Erasmus Plus Project (KA171) between the Rhine-Waal University of Applied Sciences, Germany and the Nelson Mandela African Institution of Science and Technology (NM-AIST), Arusha - Tanzania. The student mobility is planned to take place in the School of Life Sciences at the Rhine-Waal University of Applied Sciences, Germany. The mobility will be carried out as part of the students' research and learning experience related to the MSc and PhD research work developed or underway. The language of communication will be English.

#### **Mobility period per student: 6 months**

Between November 2022 and October 2025; with three different mobility semesters/ years per student (successful applicant for the first batch will travel for a summer semester May – November, 2023).

#### **No. of Student Mobility:**

Total 3 Students with 1 outgoing student per semester/ year (*Only MSc applicants are allowed to apply*); our partner University in Germany only offers up to a Master degree).

#### **Assessment criteria:**

- Students Proposal for the mobility
  - Mobility plan and timeline
  - Coherence of expected output to the MSc research focus
- The applicant's availability to travel during the period indicated by the call
- Ability to use English language in research and consultations
- The applicant's adaptability and attention to cultural differences

### **Mobility time activity:**

The maximum time available is six months. The project's travel and individual support will be entirely covered based on the grant conditions as stated in the Inter-institutional agreement signed.

### **Grants available:**

The Grant covers the travel (max. € 820) and monthly scholarship for students coming to Milan, which is € 850 per month. *The monthly scholarship is strictly related to the number of days in mobility, and students will need to adhere to the period planned and approved.*

Applications must include a detailed curriculum vitae, proposal with research activities and a full list of publications.

Deadline for submission of applications October 27<sup>th</sup> 2022.

### **Evaluation criteria:**

Proposal and mobility plan (up to 60 points)

Curriculum vitae and qualifications (up to 20 points)

Language proficiency (up to 20 points)

### **Publication of selection results:**

Selection results for the Mobility Project will be announced no later than November 1<sup>st</sup> 2021
