For scholarships short listing process, applicants must submit the following documents:

- 1) Copies of academic transcripts and certificates
- 2) A recommendation letter from the current employer and/or previous supervisor / educator.
- 3) Any publications achieved (added advantage).
- 4) A max. 2-page of Curriculum Vitae (CV).
- 5) A max. 2-page research concept note.
- 6) A max. 2-page motivation letter.
