### Marketing and Selection Process for programmes starting between August and December 2023

DAAD will distribute the call for applications via its external and partner network in the region.

It is, however, the responsibility of the partner institution as well to spread the call as widely and regionally as possible.

#### Marketing by partner institution




Figure 1: Marketing Strategies

In order to award scholarships target-group oriented it is crucial to organise the marketing preferably **region-wide**, **international and beyond your institution**. While it is reasonable to circulate the call for scholarships within your institution, you should aim to advertise the call **as diverse as possible**. Figure 1 shows the different strategies that partner institutions make use of. Examples of relevant scholarship websites are given below.

#### **Selection Process**

The selection process will proceed as described in the Affiliate Agreement. All applications must first be submitted to the DAAD via the DAAD portal. After a formal review of the submitted documents, all admissible DAAD applications are forwarded to the host institutions. The host institution screens the applications and compiles a ranking list of all applicants who are eligible for a scholarship (short-list). The host institution then sends the short-list, the pre-selection report including the explanation of the criteria applied as well as a list of participants of the pre-selection to the DAAD Bonn for final approval.

The DAAD reserves the right of final selection on the basis of the short-list.

The final selection is made by an independent selection committee organised by DAAD, if necessary including members of the coordination team of the respective host institution. The admission criteria must take into consideration that the amount of In-Region scholarship holders must generally be higher than the amount of In-Country scholarship holders and that DAAD scholarships can only be awarded to applicants who:

- have successfully completed generally a three-years university degree (Master candidates) or a two-years university degree (doctoral candidates) with above average results (generally: Second Class Upper Division or equivalent)
- clearly show motivation and strong commitment
- have thorough knowledge of the language of instruction
- have generally completed their last university degree not more than 6 years ago at the time of application
- must be nationals or permanent residents of an African country
