WHO CAN APPLY?

The target group for scholarships are graduates and postgraduates from Sub-Saharan Africa with a first academic degree if applying for a Master programme, or with a Master degree if applying for a doctoral programme who want to pursue Master's or PhD courses in their home country (so called In-Country scholarships) or in another Sub-Saharan African country (In-Region scholarships)

Female applicants and candidates from less privileged regions or groups are especially encouraged to participate in the programme!

WHAT KIND OF DEGREE PROGRAMMES ARE OFFERED?

Scholarships are available for Master and PhD courses at selected institutions in Benin, Cameroon, Ghana, Kenya, Malawi, Nigeria, Tanzania, and Uganda for a wide range of disciplines, including

Public and Environmental Health; Geomatics; Engineering (Energy Technology; Metallurgical and Materials Engineering); Natural Sciences (Biostatistics, Biology, Bioinformatics, Food Chemistry, Parasitology, Pharmacology); Agricultural Sciences; Mathematics and Social Sciences.
