OPEN CALL for the selection of **short-term student mobility** from theNelson Mandela African Institution of Science and Technology (NM-AIST) at the Rhine-Waal University of Applied Sciences, Germany. The call is part of the Erasmus Plus Project (KA171) between the Rhine-Waal University of Applied Sciences, Germany and theNelson Mandela African Institution of Science and Technology (NM-AIST), Arusha - Tanzania. Assessment criteria:

 - Coherence of expected output to the MSc research focus
- The applicant's availability to travel during the period indicated by the call
- Ability to use English language in research and consultations
- The applicant's adaptability and attention to cultural differences

Mobility time activity:

The maximumtime available is six months. The project's travel and individual support will be entirely covered based on the grant conditions as stated in the Inter-institutional agreement signed.

Grants available:

The Grant covers the travel (max. \in 820)and monthly scholarship for students coming to Milan, which is \in 850 per month. The monthly scholarship is strictly related to the number of days in mobility, and students will need to adhere to the period planned and approved.
